Did you know that Port Townsend and Chimacum High Schools have a health center, convenient for your child's medical care? The Health Center is open during the school year and is available to all students. It provides teens with health care and mental health counseling, regardless of a student's insurance coverage status or ability to pay.

Our services focus on prevention and include immunizations, asthma management, reproductive health care, and mental health counseling.

The staff is trained to understand and treat the special health care needs of teens. Our team includes a Nurse Practitioner, Mental Health Counselor, and Office Coordinator. They work with the school nurse as needed. The Health Center is staffed by Practitioners from Jefferson County Public Health, Jefferson Healthcare and Kitsap Mental Health. We can coordinate your child's care with community health care providers when available and appropriate.

Our center aims to serve young people who are uninsured and underinsured—those who have nowhere else to go to get medical care and counseling. However, many families with insurance prefer them because of the convenience. Because the Health Center relies on client fees and insurance/Medicaid billing to be able to offer quality services, we will bill insurance, Medicaid or the State Children's Health Insurance Program whenever possible. No student will be turned away because of inability to pay.

Your child can get great care at the Health Center. To get started, download the [registration form](#) and have your child bring it to school. Students must be registered, including a parent signature, to be seen for medical concerns. Your child can drop it off at the Health Center.
