Note: If the vehicle is obstructing a public roadway, notify Jeffcom Dispatch. If it is obstructing a **State Highway** notify the **Washington State Patrol**. If it is located within the limits of the City of **Port Townsend**, notify the **Port Townsend Police**.

IMPORTANT: The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office will send a Deputy to your property to inspect junk vehicles within several weeks of the request. To be classified as a junk vehicle, it must meet 3 or more of the following criteria: It must be **3 or more years old**, **extensively damaged** or **Inoperable** and have a **fair market value equal only to the value of the scrap material in it**. If a vehicle **does** meet these criteria, it is the landowner's responsibility to complete the backside of the affidavit and contact a salvage operation for removal of the vehicle. If the vehicle **does not** meet these criteria, it is the landowners responsibility to contact a registered towing firm for impound of the vehicle. For more information, see RCW chapter 46.55. **THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE LANDOWNER PRIOR TO DEPUTY ASSIGNMENT. ILLEGIBLE FORMS OR THOSE MISSING VITAL INFORMATION (VIN OR LICENSE NUMBER) WILL BE DISCARDED. THE VEHICLE MUST BE IN A SAFE LOCATION AND FREE OF BRUSH OR OTHER DEBRIS PRIOR TO COMPLETION OF THE INSPECTION. A MOBILE HOME IS NOT A MOTOR VEHICLE AND WILL REQUIRE OTHER RESOURCES FOR REMOVAL.**
