



## *Handwritten Statement Form FAQs*

- **Type of Incident:** Fill out what you're reporting to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office; if the incident was an Assault, Burglary, Fraud, etc.
- **Incident #:** This space is for the case number; if you were provided with one, please write the case number in this box.
- **"I have been informed of my constitutional rights"?:** If you were read your constitutional rights ("Mirandized") by a Deputy, sign and date here. ***If not***, leave this space blank.
- **Witness/Victim Confidentiality tick box:** Check this box if you ***do not*** wish for your personal information included on/in your statement to be subject to a public records request in accordance with RCW 42.56.240(2).

Please print and fill out the form as legibly, and completely, as you are able. The second page is provided as a courtesy if you require more room to write, however, it is not required to be turned in if you do not use or need it.

Upon completion, please turn this completed form into the Sheriff's Office at 79 Elkins Rd, Port Hadlock, WA 98339. If you are trying to turn this form outside of our normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.), please call the non-emergency line at (360)-344-9779 and speak with our dispatchers.
